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COURSE DESCRIPTION

As canonical architectural texts focus on designs and buildings of signature architects, the focus of this course is on the architectural fabric of rural and urban settlements rather than formal aspects of individual buildings. Students are familiarized with anonymous buildings and everyday environments where means of technical and cultural sustainability take precedence over stylistic issues. Ranging from climate control in vernacular settings to survival strategies of squatter settlements and migrant neighborhoods, the course addresses issues of both technical and social/cultural nature, which remain outside mainstream architectural discourses.

COURSE FORMAT

The course will be run in the form of a lecture/discussion. All course documents will be available online. In the main part of the course participants are expected to undertake weekly readings/watch video clips/check websites and work on a group project throughout the semester. On the day of discussion, students will conduct an online search to unearth more material related to the week's theme in class. Grades will be based on attendance, level of participation, submission of online research findings, presentation of term project, and its final submission.

Group Project and Presentations: Choose one of the six group project titles (see course syllabus) and present your findings in the second half of the semester. You are asked to prepare a presentation board as the final submission. *Late submissions will not be accepted.

Textbook: There is no required textbook for this course. (See next page for details on each week's required and recommended course material).

***Academic Integrity:** You are responsible for the content and integrity of your group projects. Plagiarism and academic dishonesty are serious matters. If it's not your work, don't claim credit for it. Cheating will result in disciplinary action, including possible dismissal from the course.

***Classroom Decorum:** At times, the topics discussed may be controversial. We expect you to work hard to express yourself in a respectful manner. All viewpoints that are expressed respectfully will be considered and discussed within the context of the course subject matter.
